The year witnessed many milestones of excellent achievements in academic and cocurricular activities aimed at improving the quality education and the all round development of students. I feel privileged to brief you with the achievements of our school.

Our school has been a beacon of excellence since 1987 , consistently delivering academic excellence and providing a nurturing environment to students. The strides of excellence we have achieved in all our activities are a testament to the profound impact of Sree Narayana Guru’s blessings which have been a driving force behind our success .

Academic Achievements : Let us take a look into the scholastic achievements of our class X and XII students who appeared for their CBSE board exams in the academic year 2024 – 2025. This year too was no exception. Continuing the tradition of excellence, our school’s remarkable performance is an example of its commitment to holistic education. All our students who had appeared for the examination have achieved excellent results , bringing pride to our school

There were 71 students in class X out of which 15 students scored 90% and above , 55 of them scored above 75% . Apsara Anil, Abhinav B Krishna , Anakha V, Mekha B, Avanthika Manu and Devamsh Viswam secured A1 for all subjects . Apsara Anil scored 100 % for Malayalam and IT which made her top the roll with 99 % marks. Anakha V , Mekha V and Nandana Anand’s results too were equally commendable scoring 100% for IT.

61 students attended the CBSE Class XII board exam. 90% and above was scored by 12 students 75% and above by 40 students , and all other students obtained 60% and above. Abhinand M, Malavika Manilal, Apsara Prasad, Swathy Chandra, Ashwin G Krishna, Ardra Anil and Ardra Jayaprakash

scored A 1 in all subjects. Meenakshi scored 100% marks in Malayalam and Abhinand M aced with a perfect score of 100 percent in Computer Science . Abhinand is the overall topper securing an impressive 96.6 % of marks in the board exam.

Our dedicated team of enthusiastic teachers and the unwavering commitment of students and parents have been instrumental in driving our school's success across all areas.

Our school follows the LEAD curriculum for classes nursery to class V providing a well rounded education and foster academic excellence. Student Led movement and Student Led Conference are part of our advanced learning process. For classes IX to XII we have Tata Edge digitalised learning to improve learning outcomes for children. Teachers move away from mechanical activities and find ways to help students think critically and generate ideas.

Infrastructure : We are pleased that we have upgraded our infra structure facilities including the introduction of the turf in our school ground and additional Tata Edge Classes.

We have also expanded our sports facilities to excel in their favourite sports.

Our School band is back in action , with fresh enthusiasm and energy after a brief hiatus.

Our Physics, Chemistry, Biology labs are well equipped for learning and experiments. The two computer labs with latest computing technology caters to the junior and senior group of students for their academic pursuits. The language lab is tailored to meet the needs of students to practice and improve their language skills and build confidence in communication.

Our school boasts a spacious library, stocked with a diverse collection of books serving as a hub for encouraging students to develop a love for reading and learning. The library is well maintained and regularly updated with new arrivals of books.

The recently launched Robotic Club is a step to introduce children to STEM concepts and prepare them for their future. As per the CBSE norms teachers are given training on integrating these modern learning methods into their classrooms.

Our school transportation system is well maintained and ensures convenient pick ups and drop offs from various locations prioritising students safety and security during their travel .

Student Development Plan : The school launched an integrated Entrance Coaching Programme in collaboration with the Zephyr Group exclusively for Class XI and XII Science students, aspiring for NEET and JEE. The programme provides focused coaching along with academic support through classes , conducted every Saturday and Sunday at the school premises.

Monitoring the academics, the social, emotional and personal strength of students is done on a systematic basis. Teachers in charge of the respective classes collect the data of students which helps in understanding the strengths and weaknesses of students. Corrective measures are adopted on the

basis of the data collected. Students who find difficulties in learning are identified and given extra classes and remedial work, in the school, by the subject teachers concerned.

Zephyr Scholarship test for aptitude and reasoning was held at our school for students of Classes VIII to XII .

To indulge students gleefully into reading habits , there were many programmes organised, like the observation of National Reading Day in term I and National Library week in term II. Programmes included Paint a Story, Book Review, Book Mark Design, Write a letter to Author and Poetry Writing. Class magazines and School magazines play a pivotal role in promoting reading habits and helping students refine their writing skills . Book exhibitions are held to encourage students to develop a love for reading. The school motivates students to be a part of the Young Authors and guide them to publish their own books. Some of our students have already published their books

A youth exchange programme was organised between our school and Saint Paul's Public School Akot, Maharashtra on Sustainable Development Goals . The collaborative effort provided our students a unique platform to engage with peers from Maharashtra.

As part of our efforts to promote experiential learning and foster creativity students participated in bagless day , shedding the burden of traditional learning, aligning with our school's emphasis on holistic development.

The school YouTube channel is an active platform to share students' achievements, events and updates with each class taking turns to host the programmes.

The school recognises and rewards the best classes , best readers and best teachers to encourage students to excel in academics and other activities of the school. It is a way to identify and appreciate the efforts of the class or classes that has shown significant improvement

We do have class magazines too that are prepared , edited and designed by students, serving as a platform for expression of thoughts , ideas and talents.

The school was privileged to enrol the first batch of 8 Kerala NCC Battalion unit that started in our school on November 24, the same day the Robotic Club was launched.
